Winery: Bodegas Don Diego

Region: Rueda D.O.

Grapes: 100% Verdejo

Winery: The winery's vineyards are located near the village of La Seca, and are known for the oldest plantings of Verdejo in the D.O. Rueda. The soils of their Fuente Elvira vineyard are sandy with a lot of stones, the native home to the indigenous Verdejo grape. The vineyards are located 650 meters above sea level giving cool night and refreshing natural acidity in the finished wines.

Wine: Grapes were harvested by hand during the last week of September. Whole clusters were held at low temperatures overnight prior to pressing in bladder press to extract the free run juice. The must underwent slow alcoholic fermentation in

stainless steel tanks for about 3 weeks. Afterwards, the wine was aged in stainless steel vats with its lees for several weeks more. The wine underwent cold stabilization and light filtration before bottling.
