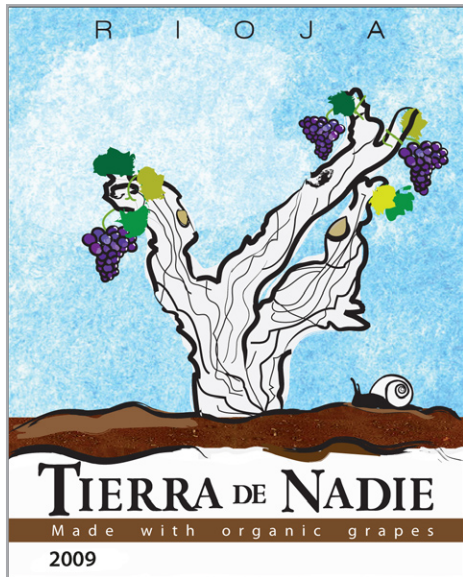


Tierra de Nadie 2009



Winery: Bodegas Vinicola Real

Region: Rioja D.O.Ca

Grapes: 90% Tempranillo, 10% Garnacha

Winery: This Bodega was started in 1992 by master distiller and winemaker, Miguel Ángel Rodríguez. The cellars are located in the village of Albelda de Iregua in Rioja Alta. They have a total of 25 hectares of vineyards in 4 different zones of Rioja Alta. Traditional, chemical-free viticulture is practiced, all grapes are harvested by hand and sorted again at the winery on a sorting table prior to crushing and fermentation.

Wine: This wine is produced from a single 6 acre vineyard with an altitude of 695m. on clay slopes. The average age of the vines is 25 years. Grapes are hand harvested into 15kg tubs. The grapes were almost completely destemmed before

alcoholic fermentation in temperature controlled steel tanks. Malolactic fermentation also occurred in steel tanks. This wine was aged for 4 months in oak barrels.



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
