Winery: Bodegas Don Diego

Region: Rueda D.O.

Grapes: 100% Verdejo

Winery: The winery's vineyards are located near the village of La Seca, and are known for the oldest plantings of Verdejo in the D.O. Rueda. The soils of their Fuente Elvira vineyard are sandy with a lot of stones, the native home to the indigenous Verdejo grape. The vineyards are located 650 meters above sea level giving cool night and refreshing natural acidity in the finished wines.

Wine: The Verdejo grapes were harvested in the second and fourth week of September, a portion of the grapes were macerated with dry ice to extract more aromas from

the grape skins prior to fermentation. The alcoholic fermentation lasted approximately 19 days at 59° F and the wine was aged 3 months on its lees for increased mouthfeel, richness and complexity.



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
