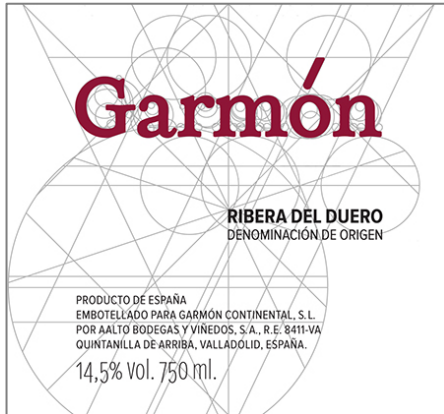


Garmon 2018 (Red Wine)
