“A very good bottle of tempranillo that bears more than a passing resemblance to a fine Ribera del Duero at a fraction of the price! The wine delivers a fine aromatic constellation of cherries, plums, a touch of clove-like spiciness, woodsmoke, a bit of cigar wrapper and a nice touch of American oak. On the palate the wine is deep, full-bodied and a bit raisiny in personality than the last couple of vintages (perhaps there is a bit of sunburn on the skins this year?), with a good core, moderate tannins and good length and grip on the complex finish.”



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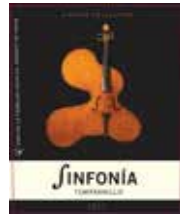
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
